

Data Inventory

Under the Government of Ontario's [Open Data Directive](#), each provincial agency is required to publish a data inventory online and make it publicly accessible. Agencies are responsible for keeping their inventory up-to-date on an ongoing basis.

Agencies are required to make datasets listed in their inventory public, unless the data is exempt from being made public for legal, privacy, security, confidentiality or commercially-sensitive reasons.
